### Landmarks

The Gnostic Centre is born... the first Brochure is ready, with the Vision, Program, Plan of Action

The Gnostic Centre gets a legal entity – Registered as a Trust

The Gnostic Centre programs begin – a series of workshops

Foundation stone is laid for the first building at Bijwasan, Delhi

The Awakening Ray – the Centre's journal is launched

The Gnostic Centre (Delhi) is inaugurated

Beginning of Talk Series in Colleges & Schools (develops into an annual series: In Search of the Soul of India, from 1998 onwards)

International Centre for Integral Studies (ICIS) – the Gnostic Centre's higher education unit is set up.

Short courses are launched.

Collaboration with Cambridge University, UK to jointly award Certificate of Professional Studies for Gnostic Centre's short courses

Pre-service Teacher Education begins. The Gnostic Centre joins the Delhi University – B.El.Ed. panel to offer Self-Development workshops to Teacher students. Thereafter, annual series of workshops with students from different colleges are held.

Children's workshops begin

1999	First book published – ‘Dhyana – Meditation for Inner Growth’ (under Interactive Self-Discovery Series). More follow later.
1999	First Audio CD. More follow later.
11 September 1999	In-service Teacher Education begins
November 2-5, 2000	The Gnostic Centre organizes Integral Education Conference. Over 400 educators from 111 institutes participate.
November 2000	A New Education for a New India – the Centre’s first Multimedia presentation is screened at the Conference. Highly appreciated by the National Council of Teacher Education, it is produced by NCTE and distributed to all teacher-education institutes in India
4 April 2001	L’avenir – the Centre’s Integral Education based preschool is born
21 February 2002	International Centre for Integral Studies (ICIS) gets a legal entity – is registered as a trust.
2004	‘The Mother on Education: From Reflection to Action’ book prepared by The Gnostic Centre and published by NCTE as well as distributed to all teacher-education institutes in India.
28 March 2007	Sri Aurobindo’s sacred relics are enshrined at The Gnostic Centre.
2007	Alchemy – the Centre’s integral health centre and the organic and health food Café are inaugurated.
28 March 2009	Quietude – the Centre’s guest facility is inaugurated
April 2009	The Centre, through ICIS, signs an MoU with IGNOU to offer online postgraduate programs in Applied Integral Studies
28 March 2010	Synthesis – the Centre’s seminar space is inaugurated
26-28 March 2011	A Collective Aspiration can Change the Course of Events – a 3-day Seminar at The Gnostic Centre

27 March 2011	First music event held by the Centre
November 2012	First check dams are made at the Aravali campus
28-31 March 2013	Academy of the Future charette at The Gnostic Centre
6 June 2014	The Monk's Retreat – the Centre's Himalayan Campus (in Uttarakhand, North India) is inaugurated
27 March 2016	Evolutionary Potential of Education – Contemplative Dialogues – a Seminar at The Gnostic Centre, by Gnostic Centre of Education (ICIS)
